Speaker profiles



Prof (Dr.) Richard Samson Odingo (main speaker) University of Nairobi

Prof Odingo was one of the first Kenyans to obtain a PhD when he was awarded the PhD Degree from Liverpool University 1963. In a career spanning five decades, Prof Odingo has achieved many laurels including being the Vice Chairperson of the Nobel Peace Prize winning Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change. Currently Prof Odingo is Chairman of Kenya's National Climate Change Activities Coordination Committee, a body that oversees the Kenyan Government's activities on Climate Change.

Prof Odingo's research interest in environmental issues has seen him specialize in Agricultural Geography, Climatology, Environmental Remote Sensing, the Geography of Natural Resources, Studies of Drought and Desertification, Studies involving Agriculture and Rural Development, Multipurpose River Basin Development and Studies on Climate Change. He has participated in various capacities in local and international organizations (UNDP/FAO/UNEP/WMO/IPCC) dealing with environmental issues, and was a pioneer in the establishment of the "Institute of Natural Resources in Africa" (INRA).



Prof (Dr) Jian Liu Director, International Ecosystem Management Partnership

Dr. Jian Liu is the Director of UNEP International Ecosystem Management Partnership (IEMP). Prior to this appointment, he served as the Chief of UNEP Climate Change Adaptation Unit since January 2008 and the Deputy Secretary of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) since June 2005. His earlier posts include Deputy Director General of the Bureau of Resources and Environment,

Chinese Academy of Sciences, Director of the Chinese Ecosystem Research Network (CERN), and Manager of Environment Program of the International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD).

Dr. Yu is the Secretary General of the Scientific Committee of Chinese Ecosystem Research Network (CERN), and Associate Professor in Institute of Geographical Sciences and Natural Resources Research, Chinese Academy of Sciences. He has 20 years' experience in integrated river basin management (IRBM), and eco-environment economics and

policies, as well as long term ecological monitoring & research and capacity development including serving as Director of Freshwater and Marine Programme of WWF China.
